CONTRACEPTIVE JELLY

This jelly is introduced to the Medical Profession as a more elegant preparation of Lactic Acid than any yet offered. It contains 2 per cent. Lactic Acid in a colourless and odourless jelly which is readily and entirely soluble, and is therefore naturally evacuated after intercourse, also because of the character of the medication, it is in harmony with the natural fluid of the vagina.

Although a reduction of the percentage of Lactic Acid in the jelly takes place when diluted with the existent fluids present at the time, its strength is in consonance with the fact that Spermatozoa are readily destroyed by increasing the Lactic Acid content of the fluid present during intercourse.

As a lubricant for Rubber Pessaries and Condoms it has a particular value; it is an additional precaution against conception, and from the character of the base does not destroy the rubber.

Used by itself in sufficient quantity it is readily distributed by the movement during congress.

It is supplied in a pure tin collapsible tube with a detachable elongated nozzle (also of pure tin) for injection of the necessary quantity. The nozzle can be sterilised by boiling.
