DIRECTIONS

Mouth Wash—*After Extraction of Teeth*—*Throat Gargle*—Use $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoonful to a tumbler of warm water, three times a day.

Nasal or Ear Douche—Use $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoonful to a pint of warm water, twice a day.

Burns, Cuts, Chafed Skin and Poison Oak—Use dry as a dusting powder, holding in place with a bandage. The bandage may be moistened if desired.

Foot Wash and Athlete's Foot—Use 4 teaspoonsful to a pint of warm water nightly. If obstinate, apply dry.

Deodorant—One teaspoonful to a tumbler of water.

Vaginal Douche—Use two heaping teaspoonsful to two quarts of warm water, as directed by your physician.

Bor-A-Sal may turn pink or violet in solution, according to the iron content in the water used.
