

BIRCOLIN

BIRCOLIN for birth control has several advantages all its own.

It is compounded by the standard formula found most efficient in the leading birth control clinics, but improved in several respects. A new chemical has been incorporated. The antiseptics are so effective that Bircolin may also be used to control leucorrhoea generally present in the vagina of all women, and for more virulent infections sometimes encountered.

The "unit" method of applying Bircolin cream or jelly permits of a consistency heavy enough to seal the parts without the aid of a sponge, rubber diaphragm or other device. With Bircolin a woman requires nothing else for complete protection. It does not run out readily and its long contact is beneficial. A douche is not required, Bircolin supplants it.

Bircolin comes in unit tubes containing the right quantity for one application, so there is no question as to whether or not the proper amount has been used, eliminating all mental strain. These tubes are small, compact and easy to use, so protection is available under all circumstances.

A Bircolin unit is a glass tube filled with antiseptic cream corked at both ends.

You can see that the glass units are full before using and empty afterwards. To apply insert about three inches into the vagina and push contents out with plunger provided. Use before exposure. It is immediately effective and you will be safe for a period of two hours.

BIRCOLIN unit tubes may be discarded after being used, or they may be kept and refilled at home, using a collapsible tube of Bircolin with filling nozzle. Bircolin may also be applied directly from the collapsible tube, but it is impossible to know the right amount has been used, and this method is awkward.

Bircolin units have one end enlarged to olive tip to facilitate insertion. They are also supplied with both ends plain at a lower price.

In order that birth control be within the reach of those needing it most, the price of Bircolin is comparatively low. One to two dollars per month will cover its cost, refilling units at home.

To facilitate the insertion of the plain units a removable olive tip of hard rubber is available for one dollar fifty, but they may be used without it.
