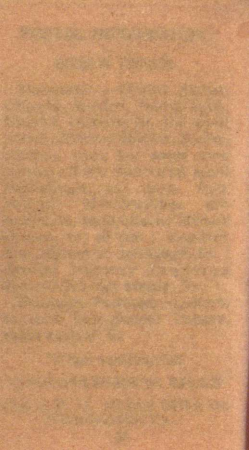

## NORMAL PULSE AND TEMPERATURE.

Normal Pulse, in adults,  
standing:

Men, 72 to 76 per minute.

Women, 76 to 88 per minute.

Children, 90 to 120 per minute.

The pulse is from four to eight beats faster when standing than when lying down.

Normal temperature, 98 2-5° F.

Fever temperature, 100°.

High fever, 104° to 106°.

The old saying: "stuff a cold and starve a fever" has cost thousands of lives.

A "cold" is only a local fever, and the *real* meaning of this much misunderstood saying is: *if* you stuff a cold, then you will have a fever that you will have to starve.

Better starve the "cold"—and then you will not have the fever.

Think healthful thoughts.

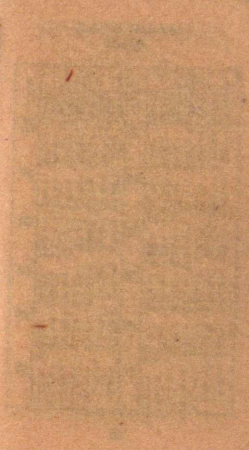

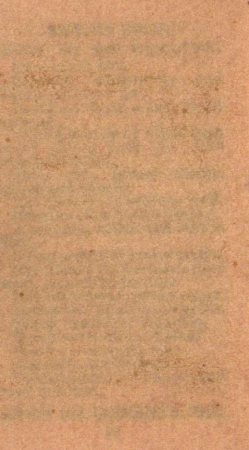

# ACCIDENTS AND EMERGENCIES.

## WHAT TO DO.

If serious always send for a physician at once.

**Broken Limbs or Bones:** keep patient quiet and send for a physician at once.

**Bruises:** arnica oil, hot applications.

**Burns and Scalds:** apply a thick coating of flour or corn starch or baking soda dredged on; lime water, calendula cerate, ozonated turpentine.

**Convulsions ("Fits"):** lay patient on back, loosen clothing, sprinkle cold water on face and chest, give fresh air.

**Croup:** warm bath, rub neck and chest with warm oil or lard.

**Cuts:** bathe with turpentine, (keep away from fire or flame). Apply calendula cerate or vaseline.

## **ACCIDENTS AND EMERGENCIES.**

### **WHAT TO DO.**

**Fainting:** lay the person flat on back; loosen clothing; dash cold water in face; give spirits of camphor to smell.

**Frost Bite:** rub with snow or ice water. Keep away from warmth.

**Nose Bleed:** apply ice water over nose; snuff up a little lemon juice or tannin.

**Sea Sickness:** cocculus indicus, 3x trituration.

**Stings and Mosquito Bites:** bathe with alcohol, weak ammonia, turpentine, spirits of camphor, baking powder in water.

**Sun Stroke:** absolute rest and quiet, lying down; plenty of fresh air; loosen clothing; cold to head, chest and neck.

# ANTIDOTES TO POISONS.

## FOR POISONING WITH:

**Acids:** give magnesia, chalk, sweet (or olive) oil, milk.

**Alkalies:** give weak acids, (vinegar, lemon juice, citric acid) followed by olive or castor oil; milk.

**Arsenic:** give tincture of iron, magnesia, milk, chalk and water.

**Carbolic Acid:** give powdered chalk, epsom salts, milk, white of egg.

# ANTIDOTES TO POISONS.

## FOR POISONING WITH :

**Alcohol:** use stomach pump, emetics, cold water, strong coffee.

**Chloroform, Chloral, Ether:** give fresh air, ammonia to nostrils, vigorous exercise, artificial respiration.

**Gas:** pure air, ammonia to nostrils, ether, warm water, artificial respiration.

**Morphine and Opium:** use stomach pump, emetics, vigorous exercise, artificial respiration, strong coffee.

**Poison Ivy or Oak:** bathe the parts in rich cream or with chloro naphtholeum, phenol sodique, or with baking soda.

## WHAT TO DO.

**Bed Wetting:** care in diet; no fluid or drink in evening; give mullein oil.

**Blisters:** apply vaseline, or cantharis cerate.

**Boils:** fast for a day or two; take a teaspoonful of epsom salts three times a day; calc. sulph.; ferrum phos.

**Catarrh:** care in diet; exercise in the open air; deep, slow breathing. No meat.

**Canker:** calc. sulph., (homeopathic, 3x trituration.)

**Carbuncles:** ferrum phos.; calc. sulph.; arnica 3x and 6x, (homeo.); epsom salts, (same as for boils); no meat.

**Chapped Lips or Hands:** calendula cerate; borax cerate; glycerine and rose water; vaseline.

**Colic:** (stomach ache,) empty the stomach; drink hot water; ferrum phos., nat. phos.

**Chilblains:** boracic acid; cantharis cerate; chloro naphtholeum; spirits of turpentine (keep away from fire or lamp); kerosene.

**Colds:** fast for a day or two; hot air baths; deep, slow breathing.

**Constipation:** one level teaspoonful of phosphate of sodium in glass of water or milk every night and morning. Eat whole wheat bread, granola, granose flakes, grape nuts. Leave off meat, tea and coffee; exercise regularly in open air. Most important of all, be regular in attending call of nature every day at the same hour. Take cascara sagrada as a laxative.

## WHAT TO DO.

**Corns:** easy shoes ; apply vaseline. Use Hindoo corn cure. Rub with turpentine.

**Corpulency:** use Chichester's "Corpus Lean."

**Cough:** ferrum phos. ; Turkish or hot air baths ; care in diet.

**Diarrhœa :** care in diet ; no meat ; take phosphate of soda ; nux vomica and sulphur, (homeopathic.)

**Diphtheria :** kali mur ; ferum phos.

**Dyspepsia:** care in diet ; no meat ; moderate exercise ; deep breathing.

**Fevers (ordinary):** fasting or very restricted diet (milk and fruit juices only). Warm baths, wet sheet packs ; deep breathing.

## WHAT TO DO.

**Grip (Influenza):** care in diet, rest in bed, enemas, hot air baths, deep, slow breathing.

**Piles:** care in diet; no meat; take phosphate of soda, nux vomica and sulphur (homeopathic.)

**Small Pox:** give cream of tartar; ferrum phos.; kali mur; digitalis; sulphur.

**Teething:** care in diet; no solid food; warm sponge baths.

**Toothache:** kali phos. 6x; merc. 6x; oil of cloves.

**Warts:** touch with a little nitric acid a few times. Rub turpentine on every day for two or three weeks.

**Worms:** care in diet; no meat; eat grains and fruits simply cooked; give santonine and enemas.

**Tan** : wash face and hands in buttermilk. Use **Chichester's Tan Remover**.

## HOUSEHOLD HINTS.

### TO REMOVE STAINS.

**Coffee** : pour boiling water through stain.

**Fruit** : boiling water as above, or rub with solution of oxalic acid (poison, use care); rinse well.

**Ink** : same as above.

**Blood** : soak in cold water.

**Scorch** : wash in soapsuds and lay in sun.

**Mildew** : wash in soapsuds; lay in sun; buttermilk.

**Grass** : use alcohol and rinse well.

**Paint** : turpentine, naphtha; benzine and kerosene.

**Grease** : same as above; ammonia; powdered French chalk; blotting paper; whiting.

Keep lemons in water.

To keep milk from souring: a pinch of bicarbonate of soda (baking soda) to quart.
